the currant shed has a long and proud history, standing tall whilst weathering over a century of different guises.

the structure was originally built for exactly what its name suggests - an undercover shed in which to prepare and dry currants before export back to the uk. dried fruit was big business back in the day before refrigeration, and there are still several old sheds standing in the McLaren Flat/Blewitt Springs area today. the one now housing the restaurant was reputedly the largest in the district, and served its purpose well for the families that called this part of the world home.

we source the freshest local ingredients and, where possible, utilise what we grow in our garden for both our menu, and our cocktail list.

not only do we eat local, but we drink local! you'll find an extensive selection of everything McLaren Vale has to offer, and further afield too.

our selection within is an exciting one, that changes from time to time with vintages and limited production, but that's what keeps it fresh. it evolves with the regions and the winemakers, and we're proud to support them.

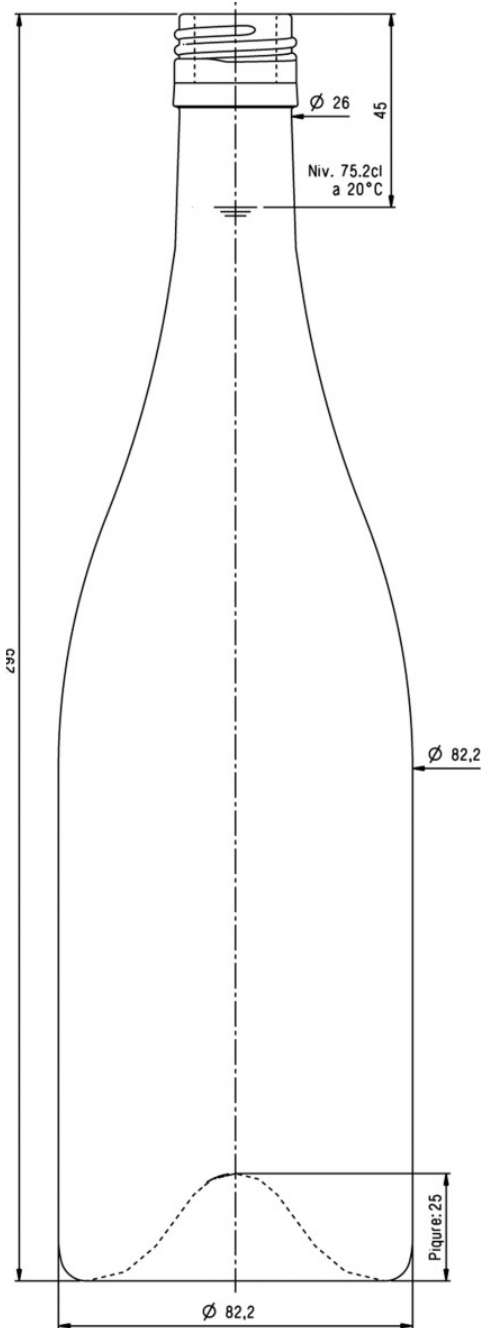

ibu - international bitterness unit - how bitter a beer is

ipa - indian pale ale - traditionally a very hop forward beer

neipa - new england ipa - a branch of ipa that has excessive dry hops

dry hop - a method of adding hops during ferment to extract aroma & flavour

kettle sour - a quick method of souring a beer in stainless, instead of a barrel

little bang little banger super session ale 3% 18 ibu 11
big flavour, big aroma, lighter on the alcohol

little bang face inverter 5% 12 ibu 11
citrus super sour that'll rip your face off

little bang the pinkening hibiscus sour 3% 10 ibu 11
shocking pink, bright berry, and floral accents

mismatch davidson plum gose (goes-uh) 2.9% 10 ibu 11
a traditional german sour dating back to the 1700's, flavoured with native plum

little bang guava s.neipa 5.1% 15 ibu 12
juiced up guava sour neipa, its been called a beertini, doesn't need a fancy glass
